- To expand knowledge about sharing through digital technologies - data, voice and video - what technologies are available for online learning.

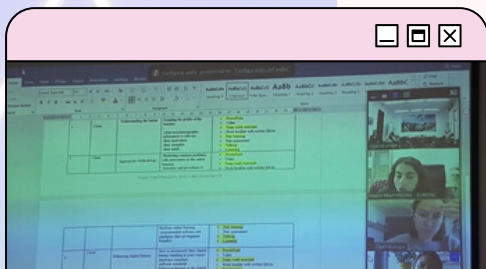
MODULE 2: COMPUTER DIGITAL LITERACY – USEFUL FOR TUTORS TO TEACH TO LEARNERS NEW TO ONLINE LEARNING

We implement this module to develop an understanding of how to approach learners who are new to online learning. More specifically this module will guide the trainer on how to best understand their learners in order to ensure a learner-centered approach, decide on the appropriate methodology, suitable for newcomers to the online learning, incorporate basic digital literacy to their work regardless of their primary topic and finally offer the chance to put in practice and built the relevant skills.



MODULE 3: NETIQUETTE - INTERACTIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS

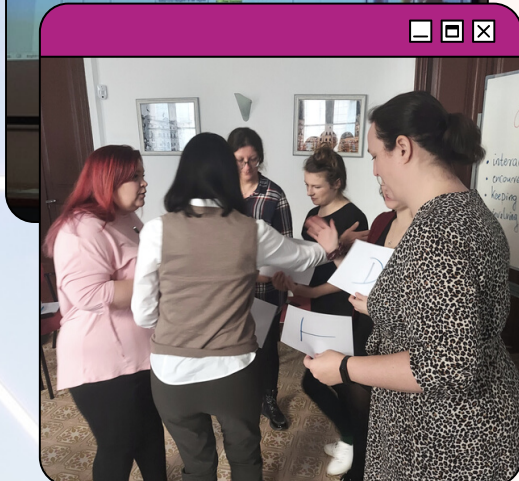
The aim of this training is to help develop your skills to be able to be aware of your social identity and the role it has on your everyday life.

- To develop an understanding of what synchronous and student-centred learning consist of in online environments.

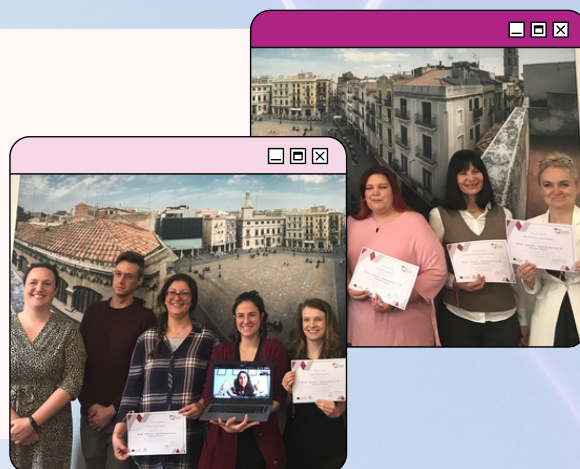
